2. Minutes of 2018 AGM

3. Committee Reports

Chair – Kerry Lessels thanked everyone for their contributions over the course of the last season. Members were encouraged to get involved by volunteering for the various roles available in our sport. Coaches, Committee Members, Umpires, Club Secretaries & Treasurers, Safeguarding Officers, are all roles that need to be undertaken if

we are to develop and manage the delivery of quality netball in the county. Volunteers are truly appreciated at all levels and the North East Region had recently given out a number of awards to members of T&W. Rebekah Talbot had won the Young Volunteer of the Year Award and Sarah Jane Cross the Volunteer of the Year and the following were awarded long service awards – Julie Bishop, Julie Waller, Susan Clark and Rachel Selby. Kerry has completed her term as Chair and she was thanked for her years of service.

Affiliations – Rachel Cassidy outlined some key points about the move to the new Engage System and all clubs were encouraged to prompt their members to do their membership as soon as possible. Affiliation costs will remain the same this season at £44 for an adult member.

Coaching – Mark Scott outlined the plans to offer more help for coaches and to put in place some ongoing coach development. Everything on offer would be available to all, even unqualified coaches.

Performance – Deborah Percy has completed her term as Performance Secretary and she was thanked for her years of service. The county has again delivered Academy and Satellite's and all players have been able to take part in match play against neighbouring counties. There have been changes to the age ranges with a move to U13 and U15 and T&W will be phasing in these new age groups in to the performance pathway. Anyone interested in getting involved with coaching county juniors was encouraged to contact the County.

Officiating – Helen Emmerson offered the County's congratulations to all those umpires who had qualified this year. Sam Moore, Jade Keepin, Rebecca Bailey – B Award; Sarah Churlish, Nicole Pegg, Vikki Smith, Hannah Slack, Julia Das, Katy Lowery and Gemma Awan – C Award. Helen outlined the positive changes since the introduction of the new rule with more umpires officiating in the league and a wider spread of matches, rather than a small group of umpires doing a significant proportion of the matches.

Junior Competition – Charlotte was unavailable to attend but was thanked for her service in the post. A list of winners of the season's divisions was displayed. Match balls were given to all the winners.

Adult Competition – All the winners of divisions in the Winter and Spring leagues were presented with a match ball by Chairperson Kerry.

Competition – Liz Wisniewski shared with the membership the comments which had been collated from the Team Sheets in the last season. Most of these related to the poor behaviour of participants in and around the court. Clubs were asked to go back to all the members of their clubs and emphasise that there are Codes of Conduct with minimum standards of behaviour which are expected of everyone. And also to play their part in ensuring that players take the court ready to play in a sporting and respectful manner.

Adoption of Accounts

The County Accounts for the year gone were presented. How we spend the money received in income by the county was also outlined. Financial support was available from the county to help with coaching, umpiring and competition. The Accounts were adopted.
