Timing Duties

As we have all three courts from 1 until 5 we can go with central timing on each of the match days. See below which Clubs have been allocated duty on which dates. Clubs on duty are responsible for timing the matches on all three courts on their assigned date/time. Please make sure that the matches run to time, encourage teams to get on and off court quickly, and collect the bell from reception and please return it at the end of the matches.

If issues arise then:

Start the courts that are ready on time, the court that is delayed will just have to catch up. If all courts are affected start as soon as you can, and reduce the time of each quarter slightly in order to catch up. Please don't run late and creep into the last hour so it always impinges upon the U15/U16s.

U12-U14 matches are four quarters of 8 minutes with 2 minutes at quarter time and 3 at half time. Which should leave around 5 minutes in between matches. 45 minutes are allocated for each match.

U15-16 matches are four quarters of 12 minutes with 2 minutes at quarter time and 3 at half time. 60 minutes are allocated for these matches.
