Reports

Honorary Secretary - Liz Wisniewski

The past year has proved highly successful again for the Tyne and Wear county. Participation has increased again and the new initiatives to increase opportunities for participation have continued and proved even more popular. Both the Winter and Summer Adult leagues increased in size with the winter league expanding to an eighth division. The Alternative Leagues, Thompson Knock Out trophy and Mixed Tournament again proved popular and will hopefully see increases in participation again in the year to come.

Facilities and their cost again proved to be an ongoing problem. Unfortunately our success in attracting teams into our League have compounded the problems of finding indoor facilities for the winter season. We were fortunate this year to be able to utilise the excellent new facilities at the Coach Lane Campus, although there is only one indoor court. Similarly most of the new developments being proposed only cater for one indoor full-size netball court. The exception is the Blue Flames proposal for 2 or 3 indoor courts which would provide us with a centre for Club netball in the area, as well as a facility, truly accessible by all. The new outdoor facilities at Westgate Community College proved a big success during the summer. Although the weather was better than in previous years, on the occasional wet or damp evening, it was quickly apparent that the new surface provided secure footing. Similarly on the darker evenings the new floodlights were brought into use and made a big difference, without causing any hazard.

Finally thanks are due to a number of committee members retiring this year after years of hard work on behalf of you all. Karen Muir steps down as Treasurer after many year, similarly Margaret Barrett who relinquishes the role of Match Secretary, Liz Barton has reluctantly had to give up her work as Development Secretary due to her new job as AENA Development Officer, and finally Helen Booth has stepped down as Committee Member to pursue her academic career elsewhere in the country.

Honorary Treasurer - Karen Muir

The Treasurer presented a Balance Sheet for the year showing a healthy balance. The Balance sheet was slightly different this year with Committee members expenses allocated against areas of work rather than against the member. We have made a slight profit this year due to an increase in membership and the sponsorship gained for the leagues. The County Squad Fund broke even and will carry forward a slight profit.

It is pleasing to report an increase in the numbers of teams taking part in our Leagues in all areas. No major problems were encountered in the running and administration of the Leagues, although the increased participation does have the knock on effect of requiring more and more indoor court time, which is difficult to find.

The past year has seen excellent performances whole range of county teams. The Adult County team continued its climb by achieving promotion to the 3^{rd} Division. In addition an excellent performance at the Inter county Tournament despite problems with the weather and injuries saw them improve on last year to finish , and even more pleasing was their Defensive rating of 11^{th} . In addition good results

were returned by County and Schoolgirl teams at all age levels. At club level Wallsend and Seatonians continued to perform well in national and regional competitions. At international level Victoria and Deborah Percy continue to represent England at their age group, and a number of up and coming youngsters in the region have been 'talent-spotted' and selected for special training and coaching opportunities.

In addition a major effort has been put into improving communication. 107 reports on Netball have appeared in the local press over the last two years. And this year 2 Newsletters were produced. Many Clubs are keeping a noticeboard at their regular training venue, and this is all helping to raise the profile of the game and attract players and money.
