SURREY STORM VS TEAM BATH

This was a fixture that was not to be missed. The reigning champions took on strong contenders Surrey Storm. Storm came out strong and immediately began to pull away from Bath who fought furiously to keep in the game.

Team Bath's slow start cost them heavily and they came in to the final quarter trailing by seven goals, having been behind by 12 goals earlier in the game. That sort of goal difference is never easy to recover from at this level of the game, but Bath were not giving up that easy.

An incredible final quarter from Team Bath rattled Storm and allowed them to creep back into contention. Both teams fought hard, dazzling the crowd with a fantastic display of skill and determination.

With 40 seconds left and one goal between the teams, Storm held possession in an attempt to run down the clock. Bath managed to pull off a vital turnover and launched a crucial ball into Pamela Cookey who scored on the whistle to rescue a 48-48 draw.

Jess Thirlby, Team Bath head coach, said: 'We played better early on but we made some unforced errors which put us on the back foot.

'It was disappointing that we put ourselves in the position where we had to chase the game, we need to make sure we eliminate the individual errors if we're going to contest and win games against the best teams.'


NETIO FOR LIFE: 2 - 16 MARCH

England Netball, Loughborough Lightning star Lauren Steadman gave us five minutes to talk about her start in the 2014 ZEO Netball Superleague.

What's the best way to get rid of nerves?

Keep busy and meet up with your team early, listen to music, chat or even watch some of your previous games back.

So the season has started, how is it going so far?

It's all exciting really! We had a great pre-season game against Northern Ireland and performed really well. But we didn't have the best first game of the season, Yorkshire Jets really came at us and unfortunately nerves led to early problems. Shelley [Norris] did get all 12 of us on court however, and we gained a lot of turnover balls from defence and positive attacks - I think if we strung them together in the first four minutes it would have been the difference. We do have two big training sessions next week though so nerves can be completely tackled head on and removed in preparation for the next two games.

Which team would you say is the biggest threat this season?


It's hard to say really! There have been a lot of changes to the teams this
