The **Agenda** for the meeting will include the following:

1. Affiliations:

- a. Timing of affiliation to England Netball,
- b. Additional Players/2nd Affiliation new process for season 2018-19
- c. Nomination process changes for season 2018-19
- 2. Officiating proposal to introduce a requirement for each club/team to have an active umpire to enter the County League
- 3. Outline of the proposal to **split the existing County League** into two separate competitions

4. Safeguarding

All clubs wishing to enter teams in the county Spring League are required to send **two club** representatives to the meeting, however as a number of important issues are being outlined and discussed clubs are able to send as many representatives as they wish. It is recommended that any club members who deal with affiliations or umpires should definitely attend.

Entry Forms will be sent electronically to Club Secretaries and published on the website. The league fee of £190 per team, must be paid on the night. Teams requiring Invoices should contact the Competition Officer in advance of the meeting to request these. Cheques should be made payable to TWCNA. Clubs who wish to pay electronically will be given a reference on the night of the meeting and should pay their fee within 2 weeks of the meeting.
